



MUNDIALITO USA INTERNAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. There is no off-sides.
2. All goalkeeper punts must be with hands only.
3. The goalkeeper's throw-ins cannot pass half court.
4. If the ball crosses the half court line when the goalkeeper takes a throw-in from his area, a throw-in from either side of the half court line will be awarded to the opposing team.
5. The goalkeeper will have 7 seconds to make his clearance. If the time is exceeded, the referee will sanction an indirect free kick in favor of the opposing team.
6. Throw-ins are with the hands.
7. Any foul, the referee will judge if it is a direct or indirect kick.
8. No slide tackles of any kind. If someone slides, they will be sanctioned with a yellow card.
9. If a player has 2 yellow cards in the same game, they will be sanctioned with a red card and will not be able to participate in the next game. If the player receives a direct red card, he will not be able to participate in the next game.
10. When a player receives a red card, the referee will take off their player bracelet so they can sit out the next game. Player will have to check in again, in order to receive a new bracelet.
11. The player will have 5 seconds to take the throw-ins, if the time is exceeded, the ball will be given to the opposing team. The player wall will have to be 5 normal steps by the referee.
12. Player wall will be 5 regular referee steps of distance.
13. It is mandatory to have a goalkeeper per team in all games.
14. Penalties must be taken from the center of the penalty area, 8 normal steps by the referee.
15. During a penalty, the goalkeeper must remain on his line.
16. The 2017 to 2014 categories, headers are not allowed, if someone does, an indirect kick will be sanctioned for the other team
17. Each team must have a coach who will be the primary contact for their team and will represent their team at registration on the day of the event.
18. All players must present a photo ID. Without exception and if it is for children and youth categories, a copy of the birth certificate as well.
19. Each player must be verified by the organizing committee of the event before their first game.
20. Each player (parent/guardian for those under 18 years of age) must sign the liability release sheet.
21. No player will be able to participate if they have not signed the responsibility release sheet.
22. Once the waiver has been signed, the players understand and accept what is written there and are in full agreement with what has been signed.
23. The roster must have a maximum of 14 players.
24. Each team must have a coach over 18 years of age, no player can be a coach.
25. There is no limit to player changes and they can be done at any time, the referee does not have to stop the game for changes, just make sure the player to be substituted is out.
26. It is mandatory that teams must wear their uniform with numbers.
27. The goalkeeper must wear a different uniform color than the rest of the team.
28. Jewelry is not permitted.
29. Any player who does not have their complete sports equipment will not be able to play.



30. All players must wear their team jersey during each game, they must bring a light and a dark jersey. If the 2 teams have the same color shirt, the "home" team must change their uniform. The alternative shirt does not need a number. Bibs/Pennies can be used as an alternative uniform.
31. All decisions of the referee are irrefutable, in case you want to file a protest, you must pay a fee of \$50 dollars to submit it for evaluation. If you win the protest, the money is refunded.
32. Each game will have a referee. Line judges are not needed.
33. The referee will check that each player has their complete sports equipment (shirt with number, shin guards, sports shoes, etc).
34. A maximum waiting time of 10 minutes will be given to start a game. The game can be started with a minimum of 4 players including the goalkeeper, after 5 minutes the game the team present on the field will be given a goal. After 10 minutes of not appearing, the missing team will be given a loss.
35. If a team wins by default, the team will win 3-0. If for some reason neither of the 2 teams show up for the game, both will lose 3-0.
36. At the end of each game, the coach of each team must sign the referee's result sheet to ensure the final result, if he does not do so, what the referee says will be official. Winning team is responsible for turning in the game report to the committee that will be located at the fields. In case of a tie, the home team indicated on the schedule is responsible for turning in the game report.
37. Once the sheet has been delivered to the organizing committee in charge of scoring, no changes will be accepted.
38. The organizers of the event reserve the right of admission.
39. The decisions of the organizing committee are final and irrefutable. In case of indiscipline, depending on the seriousness of the case, the organizing committee reserves the right to expel any participant from the event, who must immediately leave the place of the event.
40. Each group stage game will last for 2 halves of 22 minutes each, with a 5-minute break at half time.
41. In the stadium, each semi-final and final game will last 40 minutes straight, without rest.
42. At the indicated time, time begins to run and the teams have to be ready to enter as soon as the referee whistles.
43. Teams, coaches or players who violate these regulations may be suspended from the event without refund of their payment.
44. In case there is a tie in points to define who advances, the following tiebreaker system will be carried out: Step #1 Goal difference, #2 Goals in favor #3 Confrontation between them #4 Penalties: 3 players per team and if the tie continues, sudden death one shot per team until a winner is drawn.
45. Competition system: Game won 3 points, tied game 1 point and game lost 0 points.
46. If the player loses their bracelet it will cost \$5.00 to replace it.
47. They can play with indoor tennis or studs, if you wear studs, you will have to remove them at the end of your game and not use it anywhere else, the latter only applies in the stadium.
48. Each team must present a ball to play. 2016-2013 Size #4 all other categories of Size #5
49. Teams that qualify for the Semi-Finals and Finals will automatically get an entry ticket to the AT&T Stadium along with the stadium tour. Only the players on the roster, coach and assistant coach will receive a ticket.



50. Costs of Admissions Tickets to AT&T Stadium:

- a. General Admission: \$25.00 (Only to watch the games – Includes Parking)
- b. VIP: \$35.00 (To watch the games and tour the AT&T Stadium – Includes Parking)

51. Costs of Admissions per vehicle is \$5.00
